Richard Lissack QC from Fountain Court Chambers will consider the current drive to make corporate liability in financial crime easier to prove. The current Ministry of Justice consultation, the move to extend the model of corporate liability under Section 7 of the Bribery Act 2010 and the noise around similarly structured potential offence of failing to prevent economic crimes, coupled with the emergence of “Deferred Prosecution Agreements” and the increasing attacks on corporate claims to privilege all signal a singular direction of travel for the SFO and its affiliates: the company must pay for crimes in its name.
